DEROGATORY RULES COVID

RESOLUTION OIV/CONCOURS 332A/2009

Geographic dispersion in the origin of the jurors

The OIV Director General,

After consultation with the World Federation of International Wine and Spirits Competitions (VINO FED) with Observer status within the OIV,

Considering the health constraints induced by the global pandemic of Covid-19 and in particular the restrictions of movement,

Also considering the need to support the activity of the wine industry through international competitions which, within the meaning of the OIV standard for international wine and spirit of wine origin competitions, aim to:

- promote knowledge of wine and spirituous beverages of vitivincultural of outstanding quality,
- encourage their production and responsible consumption as an active part of civilisation,
- make known and present characteristic types of wine and spirituous beverages of vitivincultural origin, produced in various countries, to the public,
- raise the technical and scientific level of producers,
- contribute to the expansion of their production

Considering Article 7 of Standard 332A/2009, which defines the principles that govern the appointment of jurors in international competitions and the geographical dispersion of their origins,

AGREES, on a temporary basis, that the majority of the jurors of the members of the same jury may be nationals of the organizing country, while maintaining a minimum of non-national jurors, namely:

- at least 2 non-nationals from the host country for juries of 5 members,
- at least 3 non-nationals from the host country for juries of 6 or 7 members,

RECOMMENDS to the organizers, during this transitional period, to appoint national tasters with proven experience in international competitions,

ESTABLISHES the temporary derogatory period for all competitions sponsored by the OIV which will be held between May 6, 2020 and December 31, 2021.
