

# 2021 Catad'Or

World Wine Awards | 26 Edition

02-04 November | Hotel Cumbres Lastarria | Santiago - Chile



## The 26th edition of Catad'Or World Wine Awards and Catad'Or World Spirits Awards concludes with 1,300 samples evaluated from 20 countries

The contest that was held between November 2 and 5 at the Hotel Cumbres Lastarria registered a significant increase in its national and international call.

Catad'Or World Wine Awards delivered 47 Grand Gold, 268 Gold, 13 special trophies to the best in each category among 971 participating samples from 16 countries.

The award for the Best Wine of the Contest and the VINO FED award went to the Mediterranean wine 2021 from Bodegas RE from Chile and the Best Foreign Wine to Chateau Béla Breslava 2019 from Slovakia. The Best Vineyard of the year trophy went to Viña Aromo de Chile.

At the XXVI [Catad'Or World Wine Awards](#), ancestral peasant wines obtained 1 Grand Gold medal and 24 Gold medals. The Best Ancestral Wine went to the Colchagua Valley wine, Pequén Malbec Cabernet Sauvignon 2018 from RC Viñedos.

The red blend wines were the most awarded with 15 Great Gold medals and 51 Gold medals, the Cabernet Sauvignon, Carmenere and Syrah strains were the most awarded in red wines, together adding about 93 Gold medals, with strength Riesling, Sauvignon Blanc and Chardonnay wines. Meanwhile, Chile, Slovakia, Brazil, the Czech Republic, Australia and Argentina stood out as the countries with the highest number of awards.

Pablo Ugarte, CEO of Catad'Or, comments "in this edition we highlight the important international presence, raising its participation to 30% of the universe of samples evaluated, the interesting consolidation of emerging producers and ancestral peasant wines.

On the other hand, with the participation of 11 countries, a contest 100% dedicated to spirits products, [Catad'Or World Spirits Awards](#), was inaugurated this year, the contest awarded 126 medals distributed in more than 120 producers from 11 participating countries where Chile, Peru, Japan, Brazil and Argentina. The most awarded categories were piscos, gin, sake, cachaça and liqueurs.

The official delegates were Álvaro Peña from the OIV (International Organization of Vine and Wine), Sergio Correa from VINO FED (World Federation of Great International Wine and Spirits Competitions), Adriana Cerón, president of the Chilean Winemakers Association and Eugenio Lira, delegate of the International Union of Winemakers.

The guest of honor was France, who offered a reception at the residence of its embassy, in addition, the Czech Republic and Brazil held cultural events for the jury, diplomatic and national authorities.
